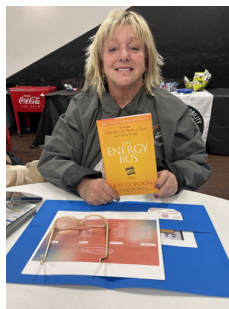

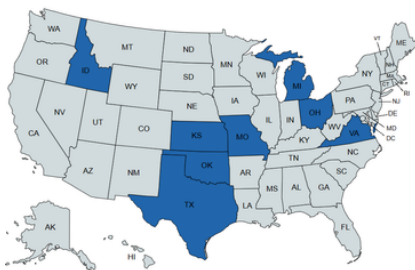

# Become a Certified Mobility Manager

Easterseals Project Action (ESPA) offers a comprehensive certification program for mobility management professionals, at all experience levels. All courses are provided virtually, taken at your own pace through our online portal, and must be completed within 2 years of initial registration.

The program requires a total of 60 credit hours; including required Foundations courses, elective hours hosted by ESPA or other agencies (trainings, webinars, conferences, etc.), and a final project. Individual registration is \$750, groups of 5 or more can be offered a discounted rate.
